- Communicates with families on a regular basis.
- Attends in-service training and any additional professional development.
- Keeps record of student data.
- Assists the behavioral support team with any crisis that may arise with the student.
- Communicates with the administrative team and staff regarding needs.
- Follows additional requests that are given by the administrative team.

- A Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) or Licensed Social Worker (LSW) designation
- Must be able to provide all state clearances for working in a school setting.
